

2020 NEW GUIDELINES

Moving forward, we have made some small changes to how the 2020 tournaments will take place in order to facilitate social distancing (please note that some of these have changed from the tentative updates that were posted in the forum earlier).

Please do not attend events if you:

You are feeling unwell or have symptoms related to COVID-19:

OR

You have tested positive for COVID-19 or had close contact with a confirmed case without wearing proper PPE

OR

You have traveled outside of Canada in the last 14 days

- Online registrations only for tournaments with a deadline of **Thursday at 8pm**, payment to be made by e-transfer to avoid costly website processing fees. No on-site registration or cash handling.
- Blast off order (Randomized) will be provided by text message to registered boaters by 9pm the day before the tournament
- Payback to be done after the event by email transfer to the registered boater
- Any socializing before/after the event must follow current government regulations in regards to social distancing, etc.
- Angler of the Year/Classic qualifying criteria will be re-evaluated once it's determined how many tournaments will take place
- The processing fee for credit cards will be added to the OFAH membership price (approx. \$2.86 per adult)

Weigh-In Procedures

- If the minimum social distancing distance cannot be maintained at any point during weigh-in, face coverings should be worn.

Please maintain social distancing rules set out by the Province at all times, this is for everyone's safety and to ensure that the public sees us behaving in accordance with current regulations. As of July 14th, this includes:

Maintaining physical distancing of at least two metres from people outside of your household or social circle

Wearing a face covering in indoor and outdoor public spaces where physical distancing is a challenge
