RESOLUTIONS FROM EXECUTIVE MEETING MAY 5, 2019

PRESENT:

The purpose of the meeting was to arrive at consensus on a number of club matters. The following were voted upon, and are effective immediately.

1. Executive Changes were made as follows:

- Treasurer Jenn Iles
- Secretary Alex McMaster
- Director Chris Little

2. Executive Authority

a. The Executives have been delegated the authority to conduct the day to day operations of the club including: format or rule changes, entry and membership fees, community project support.

3. 2019 membership fee be adjusted to:

- a. Single membership \$20.00
- **b.** Family membership: \$30 (same qualifications as OFAH)

4. Number of events in 2019 reduced to 7 events (including Classic)

5. Classic Format Changes:

- a. Change the dates to the last weekend of September (28th & 29th)
- **b.** 2 days same water body
- c. Paint Lake is OUT OF BOUNDS for the Classic
- **d.** New entry fee and payout structure (see below for details)
- **e.** Must qualify to enter by competing in 3 of the 5 regular season events
- f. Classic cannot be fished as two 'separate' one day tournaments

6. 2019 Schedule (4 of 5 events will be held on Sundays):

a. June 22nd: Hawk chain of lakes NEW

b. June 23rd: Boshkung -12 Mile chain NEW

c. July 14th: Drag Lake

d. July 28th: Kashagawigamog chain

e. August 11th: Paudash Lake

f. Sept 28/29th: CLASSIC LAKE OF BAYS

NOTE: BOSHKUNG AND HAWK LAKE HAVE BEEN SWAPPED

7. Big Bass Challenge

a. A tentative date for an additional 'special' Tournament to be hosted on Gull Lake has been set for August 24th or 25th.

- **b.** Big Bass Challenge does not contribute to being one of three events needed to qualify for the Classic
- **c.** Date and Rules will be finalized at a later date.
- d. See Pat's Board Post on the website for a general idea of formatting and rules

8. Prefishing:

a. Competitors must be off the water by sunset the Sunday night prior to the weekend events.

9. 2018 Community Projects

- **a.** \$1,000.00 be awarded to the Haliburton Highlands Outdoors Association
- **b.** \$500.00 be awarded to the Food for Kids Program

10. Event Limits

- **a.** The practice of limiting the number of entrants to 20 boats per event has been eliminated.
- **b.** Pre-registering is still highly encouraged to help with morning operations for Tournament Directors

11. Only navigable waters are accessible during tournaments

- **a.** Waters are not considered navigable if team members must exit their boat to push their vessel, or to gain buoyancy.
- **b.** Teams must stay in their boats to access all water

NEW CLASSIC FORMAT FOR 2019

- ➤ **QUALIFIYING:** ONLY Anglers who have competed in 3 of the 5 regular season events in 2019 will be eligible to fish the Classic.
- Anglers who qualify individually may fish alone or with any other qualified angler; BUT must fish the Classic (both days) with the same partner if fishing as a team.
- ▶ Prefishing remains the same as regular season. Cutoff for prefishing will be dusk on Sunday SEPTEMBER 22ND

o 1ST PLACE: 45% OF NET CLASSIC ENTRY FEES PLUS CLASSIC \$\$

2ND PLACE: 30% OF NET CLASSIC ENTRY FEES
3RD PLACE: 25% OF NET CLASSIC ENTRY FEES

4TH PLACE: \$250.00
5TH PLACE: \$250.00
6TH PLACE: \$200.00
7TH PLACE: \$200.00

> **BIG FISH**: 50% OF BIG FISH PORTION OF ENTRY FEE AWARDED TO TEAM WEIGHING IN LARGEST FISH EACH DAY.

FOR EXAMPLE PURPOSES ONLY!

- 18 teams eligible to fish 18 teams x \$250.00 = \$4,500.00
- Deduct: Big Fish Pool \$720.00 (18 x \$40)
- Deduct: \$250 for both 4th and 5th place (fixed amount)
- Deduct: \$200 for both 6th and 7th place (fixed amount)
- ➤ Money to be awarded: BIG FISH \$360.00 EACH DAY
- PAYBACK:

> 1ST PLACE: (45%) \$1,300.00 PLUS \$\$ COLLECTED DURING SEASON

> 2ND PLACE: (30%) \$860.00 > 3RD PLACE: (25%) \$720.00 > 4TH PLACE: \$250.00 > 5TH PLACE: \$250.00 > 6TH PLACE: \$200.00 > 7TH PLACE: \$200.00 > TOTAL: \$3.780.00
